Polytechnic University and Russian-Armenian University strengthen cooperation

The visit was held within the framework of the state project "Implementation of a set of measures to improve the efficiency of the Russian-Armenian (Slavonic) and Belarusian-Russian universities in training professional personnel for the digital economy through the development of research programs, programs of additional education and advanced training for students and young people scientific and pedagogical workers, including with the use of modern remote technologies". This project is funded by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation and is aimed at developing cooperation between SPbPU and two Slavic universities.
